

## HOW TO CLAIM YOUR 2021 TAX RETURN CREDIT

## Glossary

CalEITC: is a refundable cash back tax credit for qualified low-to-moderate income Californians. In 2021, Californians that file their taxes with (ITIN) are now eligible to this credit.

\*YCTC: is a refundable tax credit, up to \$1000, for at least one child younger than age of 6 as of Dec. 31,2020

Glossary

Golden State Stimulus: a onetime payment offered to lowincome Californians who face economic hardship due to the pandemic.

EITC is a federal tax credit for working people who have earned a low-to-moderate income

- None of these tax credits, state or federal stimulus checks are considered public benefits under the U.S. Citizenship and Immigration Services public charge rule.
- > If you filed your 2020 taxes already and you are eligible to CalEITC, but did not claim it; you can amend your 2020 tax return immediately.
- > Cal Works, SSI, SSP and CAPI recipients are also eligible for the Golden State Stimulus and will receive it through their most likely EBT or direct deposit.
- Make sure you file your 2020 tax returns by October 15, 2021 to receive your Golden State Stimulus check.
- > \*Some qualified dependents defined as anyone 16 years of age or younger may be eligible for the 1st and 2nd stimulus check.
