# COVID-19 Stimulus Check Fact Sheet

## WHAT TO KNOW ABOUT THE STIMULUS CHECK:

This one time payment from the government is part of a massive COVID-19 relief package signed into law on March 27, 2020. Eligible tax payers who have filed their tax return for 2019 or 2018 **will automatically receive a payment of up to \$1,200 for individuals with Adjusted Gross Income (AGI) up to \$75,000, or \$2,400 for married couples with AGI up to \$150,000, and up to \$500 for each qualifying child.**

## Who Will Receive the Stimulus Check?

- Social Security Disability Insurance (SSDI) recipients.
- Supplemental Security Income (SSI) recipients without dependent children.
- Social Security Retirement (SSR) recipients (retirees).
- Individuals and couple filing jointly with a valid Social Security Number (SSN).
- Children younger than 16 claimed as dependent with a valid SSN.
- Young adults between 18 and 24 years old claimed as dependent but who file their own tax return, they will only be eligible for the \$500 payment.

## Who Will NOT Receive the Stimulus Check?

- Dependent children aged 17 and young adults between 18-24 years old.
- Disabled adults and seniors claimed as dependent.
- Married Couples filing jointly but used ITIN by the spouse or dependent.
- People who are paying child support.
